The preparations for the upcoming spring negotiations are progressing well.

Please find below an update of the main events that took place during the bargaining caucus and a report on the elected bargaining team and the National Representatives assigned to assist them.

Bargaining Caucus

The Bell Canada Bargaining Caucus took place in Ottawa, February 19 to 21, 2013. The principal objectives were to elect two negotiators (and alternates) from each of Québec and Ontario, and to finalize the bargaining agenda to be submitted to Bell Canada.

The Bargaining Issues (Negotiation agenda)

The members present endorsed a bargaining agenda based on local demands and added some proposals to the document submitted by the National Representatives who were responsible for compiling and combining the requests received from the locals.
